## OKTATÁS CÉLJA / AIM OF THE COURSE

A thesis consultation is the solution of a Logistics task or the development of a research topic that can be prepared in one semester based on the student's academic knowledge, by studying additional literature and under the guidance of consultants. The candidate certifies with the thesis that he has acquired sufficient proficiency in the practical application of the learned knowledge. He is able to perform the analytical and planning tasks of a Logistics Engineer or Technical Manager and is able to apply his knowledge in a creative way.

### **TANTÁRGY TARTALMA / DESCRIPTION**

The deadline for applying for the thesis topic is the end of the subject admission period. The student must take the thesis consultation course in the NEPTUN system during the subject admission period (AJNB\_LSTA099) If this is not done, he will not be able to apply for a state exam. Afterwards, the administrator cannot take the course for the student, it can only be done with late course admission through the registrars' department.

The student may propose a topic to the instructor invited as his internal consultant. It is the student's task to **find and ask** an internal consultant.

The student preparing to write the thesis can **apply** to his/her internal consultant for the topic by submitting a copy of the form "*Info-sheet for thesis*" (*Annex 1*)**until the end of the course admission period.** 

It is recommended that each thesis has an external consultant but not obligatory. The thesis topic can be considered accepted if the "Info-sheet for thesis" is approved and signed by the chosen internal consultant.

Mid-term requirements

Personal consultation with the internal and external consultant at least 4-4 times.

The first consultation should take place by the end of the 4th, second 8th and third by the end of the 12th week of education.

Preparation, and submission of the thesis compiled according to this Guide to the internal consultant for final evaluation.

Deadline for the **final submission** of the thesis: **the first week of the exam period, Thursday 12 o'clock.** In the case of students applying for a master's degree in the cross-semester, **the 12th week of the study period, Thursday 12 o'clock**. (early final examination)

The thesis must be **uploaded** to the http://lib.sze.hu/diplomaleado website. The thesis/thesis upload guide can be found on the website of the Department of Logistics and Transport under Letöltések (Downloads) -> Végzősöknek (For graduates) -> Logistics Engineering BSc

#### SZÁMONKÉRÉSI ÉS ÉRTÉKELÉSI RENDSZERE / ASSESMENT'S METHOD

Preparation and submission of the data sheet, signed by the consultants of choice. Deadline: submission of a thesis by the end of the 4th week of the exam period of the previous semester.

Submission Deadline: 1st week of the exam period of the current semester

The final grade of the thesis is determined by the Final Exam Committee taking into account the results of the thesis defense.
