ASSESSMENT

The semester ends in a mark. The mark is based on four written assignments (different types of magazine genres), which have to be handed in until the given deadlines (see course description). The final project is to present the magazine (compulsory 4 genres extended with 4 self-chosen “fun pages”). The presentation should also contain self-reflection on the magazine writing process. The self-reflection should also be written and handed in on the presentation day.

Pass is above 60%.

Students cannot miss more than 30% of the lessons in accordance with the university requirements concerning class participation, otherwise, they will not get a signature for the term.
