### **COURSE REQUIREMENT**

- with **4 chosen genres** from the following ones: cartoon strips, crossword puzzles or word search, quizzes, horoscopes, jokes, poems, Agony Aunt problem-solving page, programme offer, any kinds of "round-up magazine articles": quotations, opinions, statistics, anecdotes, recipes.
- **2.making a 15-20 minute presentation** on a well-focussed topic on English-speaking culture, nation or language.
