OKTATÁS CÉLJA / AIM OF THE COURSE

A kurzus célja a hallgatók idegen nyelvi kompetenciájának, ezen belül elsősorban a hallás utáni értésnek és az olvasásértésnek a fejlesztése, miközben a nyelvtani ismeretek alapos elsajátítása a képességfejlesztéssel párhuzamosan zajlik. A szókincsfejlesztés, az adott szövegekörnyezetben használt hétköznapi társalgási kifejezések, idiómák elsajátítása szintén a tantárgy szerves része. A kurzus a hallgatókat B1+ bemeneti nyelvi szintről B2- nyelvi szintre juttatja el (lásd a „Közös Európai Referenciakeret nyelvi szintje”).

This course is a language development course with a focus on developing listening and reading skills, while grammar is treated in greater depth and is not taught in isolation but how it contributes to skills development. Vocabulary development, everyday social expressions, idioms and the context in which they are used, are also an integral part of the course. Students enter the course at level B1+ of the Common European Framework of Reference for languages and end the course at Level B2-.
