OKTATÁS CÉLJA / AIM OF THE COURSE

Course summary: The main goal of the sociology course aims to show the different factors, dimensions and aspects of social structure and stratification, social inequality, change and issues based on present day international tendencies. The course analyses sociological factors and processes on three main levels: firstly on the basic level of theoratical-social aspects, secondly on a regional level and thirdly on the global or international platform. Students should be able to percieve and analyse sociological processes as a determining factor of the political, economic and cultural dimensions of any society and that of the globalized world. The course aims to deliver a holistic approach in understanding social behaviour.

SZÁMONKÉRÉSI ÉS ÉRTÉKELÉSI RENDSZERE / ASSESMENT'S METHOD

Evaluation: assignment /40%/ (research essay, case study, review essay etc.), class work /20%/ and test based evaluation/40%/. Students have to be hand in an assignment based on a chosen topic (in the exam period) as part of the evaluation. Beside this work, students have to write a testpaper that is supposed to check the overall knowledge and students are expected to participate in class work. Students are expected to be present in class in at least 75% (3/4) of all lectures. The three marks add up the final evaluation of the students' work.
