# OKTATÁS CÉLJA / AIM OF THE COURSE

## **DESCRIPTION, AIMS**

This course is a language development course with the aim of developing learners' general language proficiency to enable them to perform their roles as primary teachers. The course is based on a coursebook.

English: New Headway Upper Intermediate by Liz and John Soars (OUP).

Students enter the course in September at level B2- of the Common European Framework of Reference for languages and end the course in December at Level B2-. For more information on what these levels mean in practice, see 'Common European Framework of Reference for languages'.

This course builds on what learners have learnt at school. There is a focus on developing the four skills: Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing. Grammar is treated in greater depth and is not taught in isolation but how it contributes to skill development. Vocabulary development, everyday social expressions, idioms and the context in which they are used, are also an integral part of the course.
