OKTATÁS CÉLJA / AIM OF THE COURSE

This course is a language development course with the aim of developing learners' general language proficiency to enable them to perform their roles as primary teachers. This course builds on what learners have learnt in their previous English studies at university. There is a special focus on vocabulary development and developing speaking and professional/academic writing skills. Students enter the course in September at level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for languages and end the course in December at Level B2+. The English course is based on materials selected from New Headway Upper Intermediate by Liz and John Soars (OUP) and Academic Writing A Handbook for International Students by Stephen Bailey (Routledge).

A nyelvfejlesztő kurzus célja a hallgatók általános nyelvi jártasságának fejlesztése, amellyel alkalmassá válhatnak az általános iskolai tanítói szerep betöltésére. A kurzus a hallgatók előző félévek során szerzett angol nyelvi ismereteire épít, s külön hangsúlyt fordít a szókincsfejlesztésre, illetve a beszéd-és formális (akadémikus) íráskészség fejlesztésére. A szeptemberben induló kurzus a hallgatókat B2 bemeneti nyelvi szintről B2+ nyelvi szintre juttatja el (lásd a „Közös Európai Referenciakeret nyelvi szintjei”) decemberig.
