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### OKTATÁS CÉLJA / AIM OF THE COURSE

The aim of the project / thesis is to develop and practice the skills necessary for the student to be able to independently identify a problem of legal/governmental relevance, raise research questions and find answers to the questions based on independent literature and legal research. The student also develops his / her thinking, systematization and academic-writing skills in connection with the course.

During the course, the student, with the help and guidance of the chosen supervisor (consultant), independently researches the literature, legal and practical background of the examined problem. Relying on his / her research, the student prepares and submits a written thesis of at least 20 pages in length, formatted according to academic publishing instructions or in the manner prescribed by the consultant.

By the end of the 2nd week of the second semester of the Law and Governance program, the student shall contact the chosen consultant and agree on the prescribed formal and content requirements. The student consults with his / her supervisor in person at least 3 times during the semester. The supervisor declares at the end of the tutorial period whether the project or diploma thesis can be submitted. In order to obtain the grade, the student is obliged to submit the finished dissertation.

The grade of the project / thesis is automatically "1" (insufficient) if it can be established that the project is plagiarism or not the author's own work. The definitions of plagiarism and the accepted method and extent of citation are governed by the dissertation guidelines and the University's plagiarism policy.

The project / diploma thesis is evaluated by a reviewer with expertise in the given field. The final grade is determined by the diploma defence committee organized as part of the final exam, taking into account the student's performance in the defence.
