Written exam in the examination period

Because of the extraordinary situation caused by coronavirus students can fulfil the criteria of the course with turning in two papers.

Paper 1. Students should choose one policy field of the EU (from the list of the description) and show the most important changes, developments and documents of the chosen EU-policy in a paper (number of words: 1200, PDF format is required). The target of the paper is to show the changes of the chosen EU-policy after 2017. The paper should contain bibliography and citations in footnotes. Deadline: 15.03.2020

Paper 2. Students should choose one current challenge of the EU (e.g. coronavirus, migration, Brexit etc.) and show the most important reasons, events, problems, effects and possible outcomes according to EU documents and news (number of words: 1200, PDF format is required). The target of the paper is to show the current situation of the chosen topic, with focus on the activity of the European Union. The paper should contain bibliography and citations in footnotes. Deadline: 30.04.2021

For both of the papers it is suggested to read and analyse the information on the European Commission's website and the relevant newspapers such as politico.eu, neweurope.eu, euronews.com, euobserver.com etc.
