OKTATÁS CÉLJA / AIM OF THE COURSE

Objective of subject:

Students get acquainted with the human aspects of the management activities (e.g. collection of information, decision making, taking measures, control) in an interdisciplinary approach. Students should understand the following HR processes: human resource recruitment, employment selection, suitability for certain tasks, HR development, practical issues of human skills identification, motivation and conflicts at workplaces.

Assessment processes

Subject requirements for signature: active participation in at least 75 % of lectures, submission and presentation of individual student work (in ppt format). Passing the test paper with at least mark 2 (satisfactory).

Evaluation method: Test paper score will be offered to students as subject score. Maximum score at the test paper: 40 points.

Under 21 points (> 51%) unsatisfactory (1)

21.5 - 26.5 (51 - 66%) satisfactory (2)

27 - 30.5 (75%) medium (3)

31 - 34.5 (85%) good (4)

35 points very good (5)

The requirements for a repeated test paper (in case of unsatisfactory result) are the same in all respects.
