The target of the course is to give participants a general perspective of the legal background of the World Trade Organization, focusing not only on the viewpoint of the WTO itself but analysing also its impacts within the European Union as well as in Hungary. The course will improve the participants' skills by explaining how this legal matter and the main sources of this field of law are structured. The starting point of the course is an approach which emphasises a fusion between theoretical and pragmatic experience. Consequently the program will equip participants with the ability to understand the real function of the legal instruments of WTO and with lightening the practical aspects, the course will offer a perspective to look behind the text of the WTO law.
