In recognition of their outstanding performance, authors of the best Hungarian and English-language manuscripts will be offered the opportunity to publish their papers in the Hungarian-language journal "Jog - Állam - Politika" [Law - State - Politics] and the foreign-language journal "Studia Juridica et Politica Jaurinensia". Both journals have been assigned a ranking by the Committee on Law and Political Sciences of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences' IX. Section of Economics and Law. Based upon the proposals by chairpersons of the conference's sections, the publication award will be awarded by the Doctoral School. The award is open to one manuscript in each of the Hungarian and foreign language categories.
